- cuff deterioration
- ✓ isolated (osteolysis)
- ✓ osteoarthritis


- Debridement /Synovectomy

- ✓ Arthrodesis






- √ 218 arthroscopies (2002-2003)
- 22 patients , 15 F
- ✓ Mean age: 51 (38 to 64 )
- ✓ Prospective assessment
- ✓ Mean follow-up: 17 months (12 to 29)

- ✓ ACJ symptoms for > 6 months
- ✓ High Painful arc
- ✓ Positive provocative & injection tests



#### Advantages of Arthroscopic ACJ Excision

- ✓ less soft tissue trauma
- ✓ less pain
- ✓ improved cosmesis
- concurrent exam of the glenohumeral joint and subacromial bursa



#### Disadvantages of Arthroscopic ACJ Excision

- technically more demanding
- equipment dependent
- ✓ steep learning curve

In appropriately selected patients ACJ excision provides favorable functional results combining limited morbidity and minimal complications
